
Crisis Leadership



Gautam Mukunda is the author of the book “**Indispensable: When Leaders Really Matter**”, published by Harvard Business Review Press. He is a Research Fellow at the Harvard Kennedy School's Center for Public Leadership. Before that he was an Assistant Professor at Harvard Business School. Gautam was previously at Fellow resident at the MIT's Center for International Studies.

He received his PhD from MIT in Political Science and an A.B. in Government from Harvard. His research focuses on leadership, international relations, and the social and political implications of technological change.

Before graduate school he was a consultant with McKinsey & Company. He is founding Managing Director of The Two Rivers Group, a strategy consulting firm focusing on applying insights from academia to private and public sector problems. He is on the Board of Directors and Chair of the Mentorship Committee of The Upakar Foundation, a national non-profit devoted to providing college scholarships to underprivileged students of South Asian descent. He has published articles on leadership, military innovation, network-centric warfare, and the security and economic implications of synthetic biology in Security Studies, Parameters, Politics and the Life Sciences, Systems and Synthetic Biology, and the Washington Post.
